Are you a sporty cyclist looking for a new challenge? This route takes you through the picturesque Altmühltal valley, from Eichstätt to Regensburg. Varied landscapes, historic castles and charming villages await you on around 110 kilometres. From the starting point in Eichstätt, along the idyllic route through the Altmühltal valley, to the UNESCO World Heritage city of Regensburg, you will experience a fascinating combination of nature and culture. This tour is ideal for all those who love sporting challenges and at the same time want to enjoy the highlights of a region steeped in history.

- Closest airports: Nuremberg, Munich
- Train station: Eichstätt

Parking in Eichstätt

- In Eichstätt there is free parking a little outside on the parking lot P6 Volksfestplatz.
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Eichstätt

In the middle of the Altmühltal Nature Park, the bishop's town of Eichstätt welcomes you on your bike tour to Passau. During a first exploration tour through the baroque old town, you will discover numerous beautiful corners and squares. With the Eichstätt Cathedral you will encounter one of the most important architectural monuments in Bavaria. Stroll through the Residenzplatz past the former seat of the prince bishops and enjoy the first evening of your bike tour in one of the many restaurants.

Day 2: Eichstätt – Riedenburg, approx. 75 km

In Eichstätt take the opportunity before you leave to visit the Jura museum, which has lots of fossils of dinosaurs from the area. Your cycle tour takes you through a wonderful nature reserve, the core of the Altmühl Valley, passing Kipfenberg Castle. Via Beilngries and Dietfurt, where you follow the Altmühl through the Main-Danube canal, you quickly get to Riedenburg, known as the pearl of the Altmühl valley.

Day 3: Riedenburg – Regensburg, approx. 55 km

You cycle along the canal to Essing, which features Europe's longest wooden bridge. Just round the corner is the Schulerloch stalactite cave, bedroom to bats in the winter - but can be visited in the summer. After a short section cycling, you soon arrive in Regensburg. The town is considered Germany's best-preserved major town and has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day 4: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
