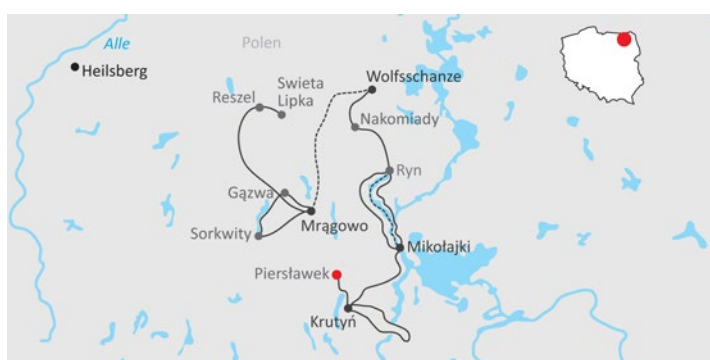
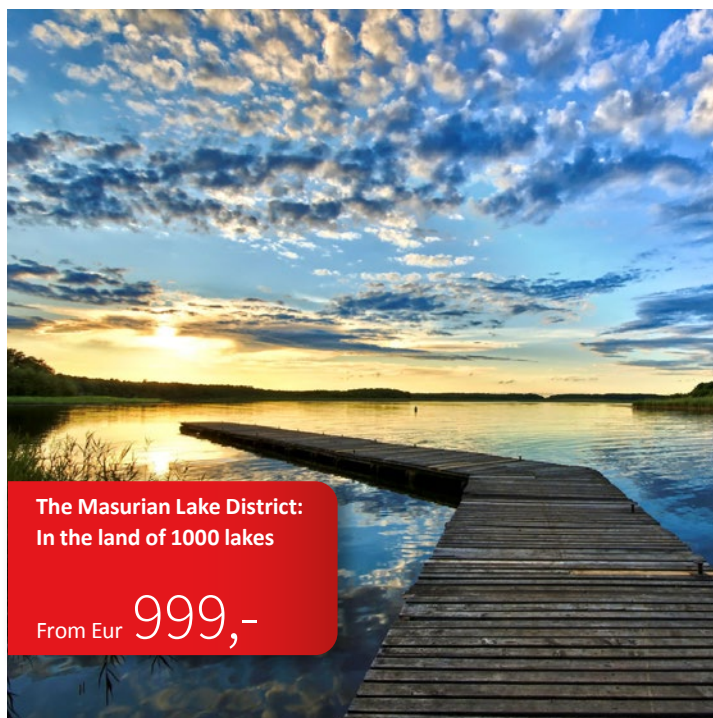


Cycle tour in Masuria

Your tour

On the cycle tour through Masuria, you will experience the peaceful tranquillity of the vast forests and nature parks, the vast heathlands and the crystal-clear rivers and lakes of the Masurian Lake District. Explore this idyllic corner of the world where time seems to have stood still. Masuria is considered one of the most beautiful regions in Poland, and rightly so. Small picturesque villages, places steeped in history such as the Wolf's Lair and Polish hospitality make this unique region an ideal destination. The start and finish of your cycle tour through Masuria is Warsaw. The capital of Poland combines modernity and history in equal measure. See for yourself!

Itinerary

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Warsaw

Explore the Polish capital on your own on your day of arrival. Take your first walk through the largest city in Poland. Discover historic buildings located not far from the most modern skyscrapers. The outstanding Palace of Culture from the 1950s and the Royal Castle near the banks of the Vistula are some of the city's many sights. If you still have time, take a stroll through Łazienki Park, Warsaw's largest park at 80 hectares. We have listed the Polish and German place names in the itinerary for your orientation.

Day 2: Warsaw – Piersławek (bus transfer), Piersławek – Krutyń, approx. 15 km

After breakfast, you will have the opportunity to take part in a city tour of Warsaw. At around 3.30 p.m., you will then take the coach to the Masuria region, around 200 kilometres away. From a beautiful spot in the Johannsburg Heath (Puszcza Piska), you will set off on the first short cycle stage to Krutyń (Krutinnen).

Day 3: Excursion Puszcza Piska Forest, approx. 50 km

Today's stage centres on the Johannsburg Heath. The largest forest area in Masuria is characterised by its biodiversity. You cycle to Wojnowo (Eckertsdorf), where you have the opportunity to visit the Philippe Monastery on the banks of Lake Drusen. On the return journey, visit the Marion Dönhoff Salon in Gałkowo (Galkowen), in memory of one of the most important publicists of the German post-war period.

Day 4: Krutyń – Mikołajki, approx. 40 km

Today is all about nature! You cycle northwards through wonderfully tranquil forests, secluded moorland and past sparkling lakes across the Masurian Landscape Park. A ferry will take you to Mikołajki (Nikolaiken), where you will spend the night today and tomorrow.

Day 5: Roundtrip from Mikołajki, approx. 35 km + boat trip

Today you cycle round the most beautiful corners of the Masurian Landscape Park. In the morning, you will travel by boat from Mikołajki to Ryn. The cycle tour takes you through picturesque villages and past Masurian canals. In Mikołajki, don't miss the view from the bridge of the fountain sculpture of the mystical Stinthenst, the heraldic animal of Mikołajki.

Day 6: Nikolaiken – Sensburg, approx. 45 km + transfer

Today you are on the trail of history. A bus transfer will take you via Kętrzyn (Rastenburg) to the Wolf's Lair. If you like, you can take a guided tour of the remains of the impressive former military operations centre of the German Wehrmacht, which is located in the middle of a wooded area. You then cycle to Kętrzyn/Rastenburg, where you can spend your lunch break. In the afternoon, continue cycling via Nakomiady/ Eichmedien to Mrągowo (Sensburg), where you will spend the night today.

Day 7: Round trip from Sensburg, approx. 50 km

On today's stage of your cycle tour through Masuria, you will cycle through the region around Mrągowo (Sensburg). Enjoy the peace and solitude of the region and above all: pure nature! Take a break in Sorkwity (Sorquitten), visit the pretty church and make yourself

comfortable with a picnic by the lake. Continue via the stork village of Gązwa (Gonswen) back to Sensburg. Take a walk along the lakeshore in the evening.

Day 8: Sensburg – Heiligelinde – Rössel, approx. 30 km, Rössel – Warschau (transfer)

In the morning, you first cycle to Święta Lipka (Heiligelinde). The village is one of the most famous Polish Marian pilgrimage sites. According to legend, the beautiful baroque church in the centre of the village was

built on a spot where a lime tree is said to have performed miracles. The tour continues to Reszel (Rößel). Visit the former castle of the Teutonic Order. In the 13th century, it made a significant contribution to the development of the town of Reszel. In the afternoon, a coach transfer takes you to Warsaw.

Day 9: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
