The Canal de Garonne is part of the ambitious construction project "Canal of the Two Seas", the connection between the Atlantic and the Mediterranean. The waterway between Bordeaux and Toulouse is a popular destination for water sports enthusiasts, houseboats and cyclists who find an idyllic landscape: Water birds, delicious food and sleepy French villages lie along the way. And also many a structural curiosity such as canal bridges that take the water over other rivers.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Bordeaux

If you have a little time left after your arrival in Bordeaux, use it to visit the wine metropolis. Whether the Miroir d'Eau water level, the Cité du Vin wine museum or the Chartrons artists' quarter - there is no shortage of sights. To get in the mood for your cycling tour along the Canal de Garonne, treat yourself to a glass of the famous Bordeaux wine in the evening.

Day 2: Bordeaux – Camiran, approx. 65 km (Cat A), Bordeaux – Frontenac approx. 45 km (Cat B)

On the very first stage, you cycle through the beautiful landscape of the Entre Deux Mers wine-growing region. Some of the vineyards have been cultivated by monks for centuries. Medieval towns as well as meadows and forests accompany you on the well-maintained cycle paths. A stop at the former fortifications in Créon is worthwhile.

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Day 3: Camiran – Le Mas d'Agenais, approx. 45 km (Cat A), Frontenac – Le Mas d'Agenais, approx. 55 km (Cat B)

First, you drive along the "green way" for a while, which takes you far away from the traffic on old railway tracks to Sauveterre-de-Guyenne. The small town of La Réole is not only worth seeing because of its well-preserved medieval town wall - here you also have a beautiful view of the Garonne. In Le Mas d'Agenais you will come across a real treasure: inside the Romanesque church there is a genuine Rembrandt painting!

Day 4: Le Mas d'Agenais - Sérignac sur Garonne, approx. 45 km

On your bike tour along the Canal de Garonne, you will mostly cycle directly along the banks. Again and again, orchards line your path. You cycle through centuries-old, charming villages where it is worth taking a short break. You will spend the evening and the night in Sérignac in a small hotel, which used to be a monastery.

Day 5: Sérignac sur Garonne - Moissac, approx. 55 km

You cycle along the canal past richly bearing fruit trees and gentle vineyards. The small town of Agen is not only known for its old town worth seeing, but also for the plums that grow in the surrounding area. A special highlight is the Agen canal bridge. Shipping traffic is guided here over a 549 m long bridge over the Garonne. On the pleasantly shaded riverside path on sunny days, you cycle to Moissac.

Day 6: Moissac - Toulouse, approx. 65 km

The last stage of your cycle tour along the Canal de Garonne is already upon you. Shortly after Moissac, the next canal bridge awaits you, built over the river Tarn. You cycle comfortably along always flat paths to the lively city of Toulouse. Toulouse owes its nickname "the pink city" to its numerous brick buildings. Whether you visit the Saint-Sernin Basilica and the Capitole or simply relax on the banks of the Garonne is up to you.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
