Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Rotterdam

Before you start your cycle tour in Zeeland, use the time to explore Rotterdam. The city has many facets. On the one hand, you will find the historic city centre with some buildings worth seeing, such as the town hall and the Sint-Laurenskerk. On the other hand, Rotterdam is a trendy and chic artists' and shopping city with a modern skyline. Discover the large market hall with delicious delicacies or Europe's largest harbour on a round trip.

Day 2: Rotterdam - Willemstad, approx. 70 km

Leave Rotterdam behind you and cycle to Kinderdijk first. The 19 world-famous windmills of the small town greet you from afar. An ideal spot for a first souvenir photo. A few leisurely kilometres further on you reach Dordrecht. The best way to explore Holland's oldest city is by whisper boat. The first stage of your cycle tour in Zeeland ends in Willemstad, a small, typically Dutch fortified town.

Day 3: Willemstad – Zierikzee, approx. 55 km

You leave Willemstad and first reach the island of Goeree-Overflakkee. A true paradise for nature lovers: Extensive polders and nature reserves alternate with small villages with Dutch flair. Continue to the island of Schouwen-Duiveland, known for its beautiful beaches. You will find plenty of small boutiques in the harbour town of Zierikzee. The sunset is particularly beautiful during an evening stroll along the beach promenade.

Day 4: Zierikzee – Vlissingen – Middelburg, approx. 60 km

The Zeeland Bridge is around 5 kilometres long and takes you from Zierikzee to Noord-Beveland. The island lies between the Oosterschelde and the Veerse Meer. On the Walcheren peninsula, Fort Rammekens is well worth a visit. A tour of the fort offers a marvellous view of the Westerschelde at no extra cost. Afterwards, take a stroll along the longest promenade in the Netherlands: the cool harbour town of Vlissingen is a great place to relax. Today's destination is Middelburg, the capital of the Dutch province of Zeeland. There are plenty of sights to discover in the winding alleyways.

Day 5: Middelburg – Ouddorp, approx. 60 km

Your cycle stage takes you northwards across the island. The landscape alternates between forests, old villages and small towns. In the Kop van Schouwen nature reserve, you can completely forget about everyday life. Again and again, wide, golden sandy beaches invite you to take a dip in the cool water. The Delta Works are an absolute highlight. The largest storm surge barrier in the world is made up of a total of 13

structures. An imposing construction of dams, dykes and locks. You will spend the night in the tranquil seaside resort of Ouddorp. The beach is also just around the corner.

Day 6: Ouddorp – Rotterdam, approx. 60 km

You leave the island of Goeree-Overflakkee and cycle to the island of Vorne-Putten. The Harlingvlietdam is the sixth structure of the Delta Works and guides you with fantastic views over the sea. You then pass the medieval town of Brielle and the maritime town of Maassluis. There are plenty of listed buildings to discover in the historic town centre. Via Vlaardingen and Schiedam you finally reach Rotterdam, the starting point of your cycle tour. With many great impressions in your luggage, you can round off the evening in one of the many restaurants.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
