Your tour

This varied tour along the Baltic Sea takes you past the fine sandy beaches and through the unspoilt coastal landscape of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern. Pack your bathing gear, you can jump into the Baltic Sea at any time! But that's not all: important, once rich Hanseatic cities with typical brick architecture, fishing villages, a "Bodden" lagoon landscape and boat trips make this cycle tour to one of our guests' favourites.

Journey to Lübeck

- → Closest airports: Hamburg
- → Train station: Lübeck Hauptbahnhof (main station)

Parking in Lübeck

- → Public car parks, cost approx. 10 EUR / day
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.

Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Lübeck

Your bike tour starts in the old, magnificent Hanseatic city, which was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. If you talk about Holstentor, marzipan and Thomas Mann, Lübeck immediately comes to mind. You should not miss a fish roll as a prelude to your vacation.

Day 2: Lübeck – Gross Schwansee / Boltenhagen, approx. 35 / 45 km + ferry trip

In Travemünde you can take a break to see Germany's oldest lighthouse, before continuing along the coast. Cycling through the Brooker Wald nature reserve, you soon reach Boltenhagen, the second oldest seaside resort in Mecklenburg. You can look over the entire bay from the cliffs. Alternatively you spend the night in Gross Schwansee.

Day 3: Boltenhagen - Wismar, approx. 45 / 30 km

Today we will travel mostly along the shore to the beautiful Hanseatic city of Wismar. Here, after an extensive tour through the historic old town, a detour to the harbor is worthwhile.

Day 4: Wismar – Kühlungsborn / Warnemünde, approx. 45 / 65 km + ferry & train ride

Today you have the opportunity to pay a visit to the island of Poel. Take the ferry to the small island, enjoy the peace and quiet and have fun swimming on one of the many island beaches. Alternatively, cycle close to the coast to the Baltic seaside resort of Kühlungsborn. If you are staying overnight in Warnemünde, take the steam-powered Molli spa railway from Kühlungsborn, which will take you comfortably to Heiligendamm. It is only a few kilometres to Warnemünde.

Day 5: Kühlungsborn – Wustrow / Ahrenshoop, approx. 30 – 60 km + ferry ride

Before you get to know the Fischland-Darß-Zingst peninsula today, Warnemünde offers a visit to the widest beach on the German Baltic coast. Or how about a detour to the Hanseatic city of Rostock? In Warnemünde you will take the ferry to Hohe Düne and reach Ribnitz-Damgarten with its amber museum or the former fishing village Wustrow or the artist village Ahrenshoop.

Day 6: Ahrenshoop - Zingst / Barth, approx. 30 - 60 km

Discover the "Darßer Wald" (Darss woods) and the romantic of the wild west beach, which is considered to be one of the most beautiful beaches in Europe. From Prerow it can only be reached by foot, by bike or by horse-drawn carriage. Via Zingst, you cycle back to the mainland, to the former Swedish town of Barth.

Day 7: Zingst - Stralsund, approx. 60 / 45 km

Look forward to the last section of your tour: the three towers of the Hanseatic town of Stralsund beckon from afar. Its former importance as a trading town can still be seen today. Let your evening come to a pleasant end in the old town, which has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage site because it has been so beautifully preserved.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
